This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the papers formerly read together with the exception of Robert McCauley as to ^{the} credit of eighty dollars claimed by the defct Warburton for money paid by the sd defct towards the execution in favor of John H. Burson against the defct Mary Ellarburton - ^{for her share} and the deposition of William S. Healy, taken & filed in this cause since the conferring thereof. On consideration whereof the Court sustaining the said exception doth a.o. &c. that Robert McCauley do pay to Warburton the sum of ten dollars, that being the difference between the sum aforesaid credit of eighty dollars claimed by the defct Warburton and the sum of ninety dollars received in the hands of sd Robert McCauley by a former decree in this cause to avail the result of the exception aforesaid, with int. thereon from the 12th day of May 1857 till paid, another suit having now fully attained its object it is ordered that the same be struck from the docket of this Court.
