

Virginia.

At a Circuit Court continued by adjournment and held for the City of Williamsburg and County of James City, at the Court house in the said City, on Saturday the tenth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.

Robert W. Canaleigh assignee of Ches. C. Sheldon and John M. Maupin late merchants and partners trading under the firm and style of Sheldon and Maupin - - - - - Pet.

This day came the plaintiff by Robert W. Canaleigh, Gent: his attorney, and the defendant being solemnly called, and not appearing. Therefore, it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of One thousand and thirty eight dollars and ninety one cents, that being the debt in the declaration mentioned, with six per centum per annum interest thereon from the first day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty until paid; and also his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended; and the said defendant in money &c.

Plaintiff's costs Three dollars and fifty nine cents.

And on the 15th day of May 1851. the following execution was issued upon the foregoing Judgment, to wit:

The Commonwealth of Virginia, to the Sheriff of James City County, greeting: We command you that of the goods and chattels of Mary E. Wadburton, in your bailiwick, you cause to be levied the sum of One thousand and thirty eight dollars and ninety one cents, with six per centum per annum interest thereon from the first day of July 1850 until paid; which Robert W. Canaleigh assignee of Ches. C. Sheldon and John M. Maupin late merchants and partners trading under the firm and style of Sheldon and Maupin, late in our Circuit Court for the City of Williamsburg and County of James City hath recovered against the said Mary E. Wadburton, for debt; also Three dollars and fifty nine cents, which to the said Robert W. Canaleigh assignee as aforesaid in the said Court were adjudged for his costs, by him about his suit in that behalf expended, whereof the said Mary E. Wadburton is convict, as appears to us of record. And how you shall execute this writ, make known at the [redacted] to the holder in the Clerk's Office of our said Circuit Court, on the first Monday in August next. And have them there this writ. Witness Thomas C. Cogbee, Clerk of our said Court, at Williamsburg, this 15th day of May 1851, and in the 70th year of the Commonwealth.
