

The Commonwealth of Virginia, to that Sheriff of James City County, greeting: You
are hereby recommended to summon May C. Wadsworth, Robert Wadsworth, Thomas S.
Harris and William S. Spencer, to appear at the Clerk's Office of our said County for the
City of Williamsburg and County of James City, at the Rules to be chosen for the said
Court, on the first Monday in July next, to answer a writ in Chancery exhibited
against them in the said Court, by Robert M'Callister: And unless the said
defendants shall answer the said writ within two months thereafter, the Court
will take the same for confesso, and render the matter thereof accordingly: And
that they shall in no wise omit, under the penalty of one hundred pounds each,
And, have then therewith writ. Witness, Thomas O. Boglice, Clerk of our said Court, at
Williamsburg this 18th day of June 1851, and in the 5th year of the Commonwealth.

Wadsworth to the defendant Spencer being made on the 13th of May 1851, and a decree in
James City County Court, as to please beyond the orders of the Court: But the said
writ is not to have the benefit of this order until he or some one for him has entered
into bond with good security in the penalty of one hundred dollars with conditions to
pay and satisfy all costs and damages which may be sustained by reason of this
Injunction in case it shall hereafter be dissolved.
