This cause come on again this day to be heard upon the papers formerly read together with the reports of William Spencer made under a decree rendered in this cause on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 157 and also further decree pronounced in said cause on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 152 which said reports have not been heretofore confirmed, and the further report of Commr Wm M. Moody also made under said decree of May 13<sup>th</sup> 152 and was argued by Counsel; on consideration whereof the Court doth a o s a that the several reports aforesaid be confirmed. And the Court doth further a o s a that William Spencer, Trustee, do pay unto collect the bonds taken by him for the purchase money of the <sup>personal</sup> property sold by him under the former decrees in this cause <sup>and out of the proceeds</sup> <sup>trusts and files in the papers of this cause</sup> <sup>with interest thereon at the rate of 6 p. cent</sup> thereof pay to Robert Warburton and Thos D Harris the several sums of money following to wit: To Robert Warburton the sum of  $\$756.96$  being the aggregate of debts nos 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6 & 7 reported by Commr Moody to be due from the deft Mory. S. Warburton, and the further sum of  $\$145$  aggregate of debts nos 8. & 9. reported to be due as aforesaid with legal int. thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 152 <sup>from the deft Mory. S.</sup> and the further sum of  $\$135.30$  reported by the Commr to be due upon the settlement of the guardianship debts of the said Robert Warburton, with legal int. thereon from 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 157 <sup>from the deft Mory. S.</sup> has paid: To Thos D Harris the sum of  $\$355.73$  the aggregate amount of debts nos 1. 2. 3. 4 & 8. reported by the said Commr to be due from the deft Mory. S. with int. thereon at the rate of 6 p. centane from the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 157 <sup>has paid</sup> And the Court doth further a o s a that out of the surplus in the bonds of said Spencer if any there be, he pay to Robert Mc Candlish the sum of  $\$1,005.00$  with ~~not~~ legal int. on part thereof the sum of  $\$1,038.91$  part thereof from July 1<sup>st</sup> 150.
