are still full but prices for Manufac-
turing in good demand Aug 14⁵⁰ @ 7⁰⁰
Leaf 5⁵⁰ 8⁵⁰ to 12⁷⁵ fine Shipping and
Manufacturing \$18⁵⁰ \$18⁵⁰ to 15⁰

Our wheat has opened with light receipts
and few only white is in demand at \$1⁴⁰
and \$1³⁰ my Miller anxious to buy to get
stock on hand
