to. nite, how I hate this kind of weather.

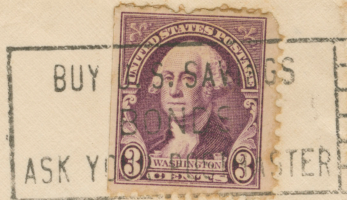
Oh, yes Willie has new glasses, his

Dearest Mary,

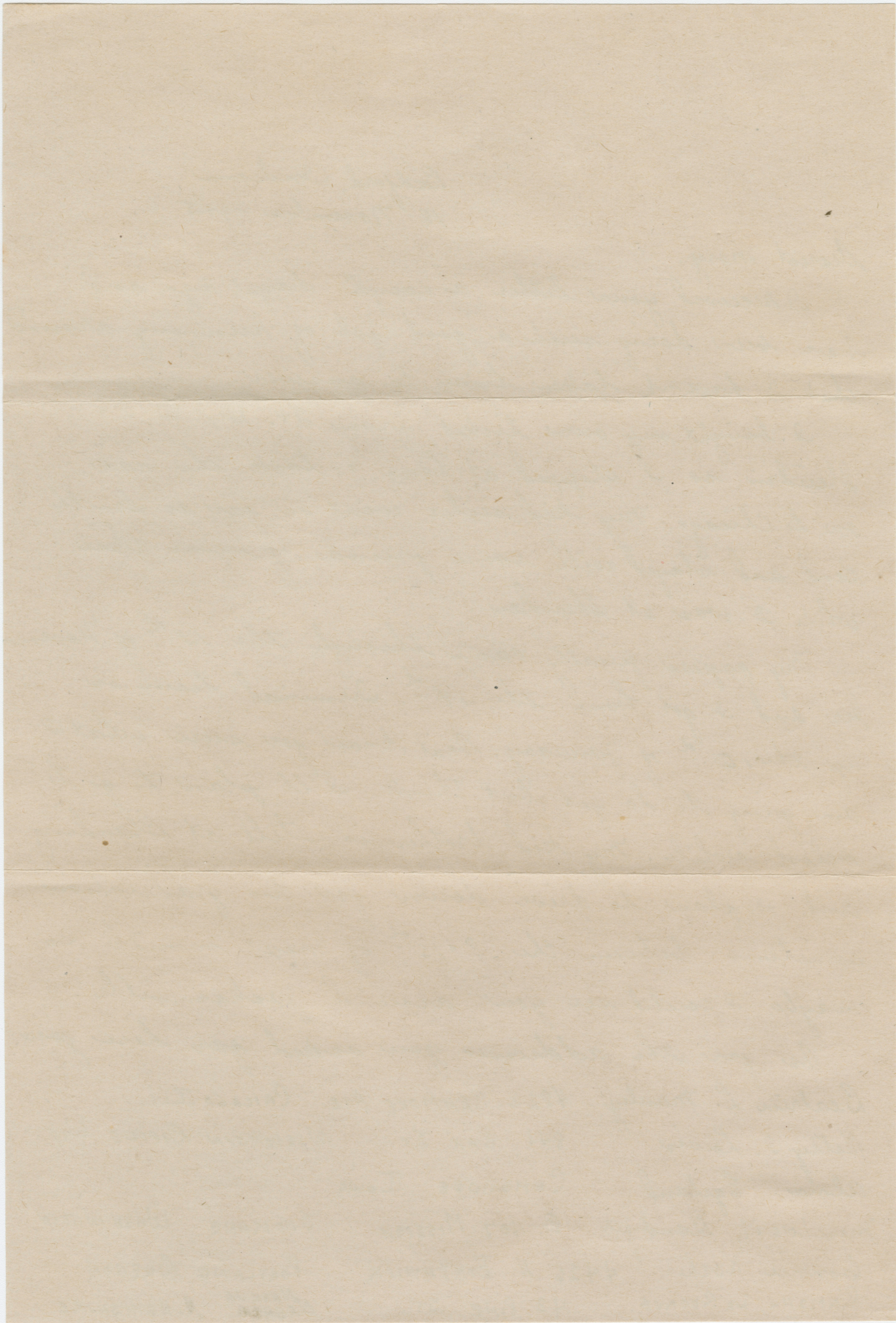
I received your letter a couple days ago and have been doing such a good job of running around that I haven't taken time to answer.

Are you coming to Louisville any way near soon? If you do look me up.

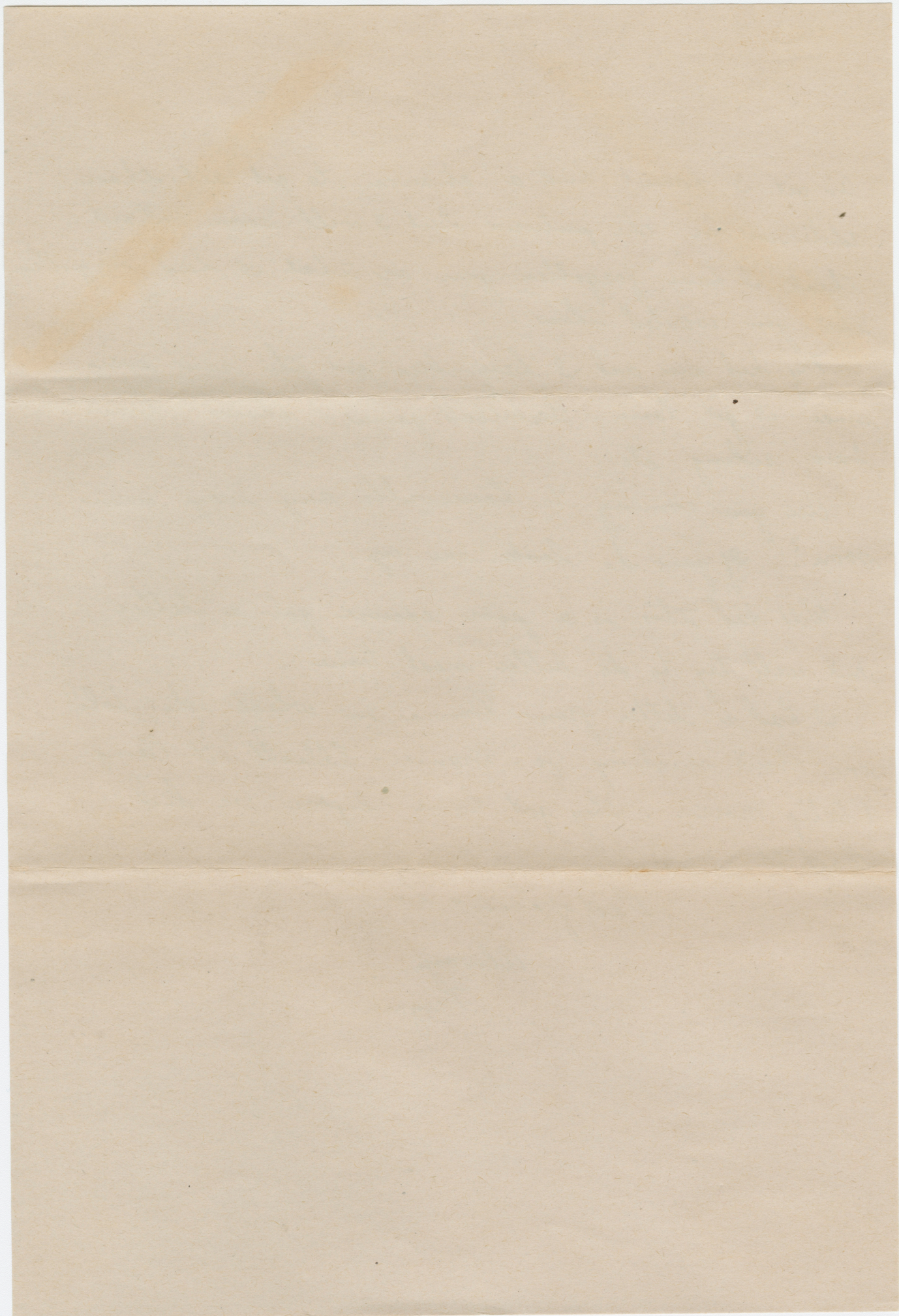
Well kid this is a poor excuse for a letter but will try to do better next time.

I had a letter from Donna in which she told me about meeting Jo - Bramer - Elliott at Camp Philip Morris. They got home before we did. A rat it.

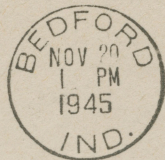

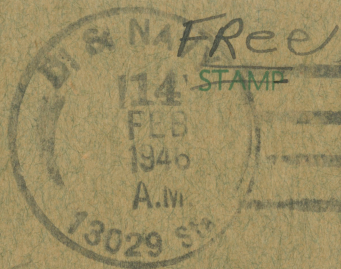
