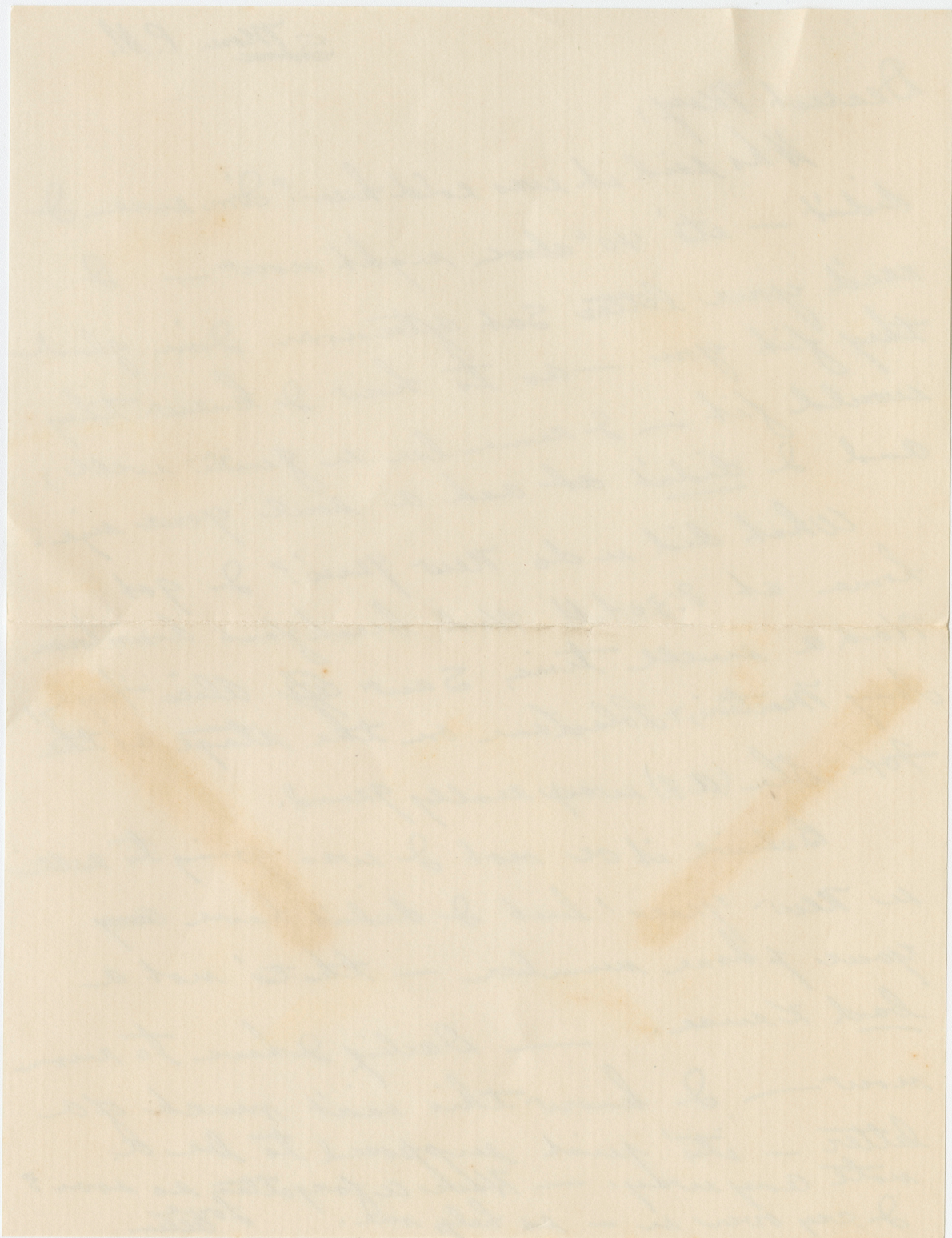
Dearest Mary,

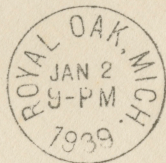

Affaire de Excursions.



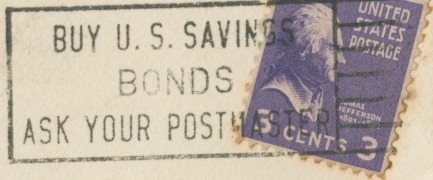
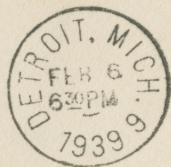
It was grand out today warm and yet

I'll try and recover my lost status —

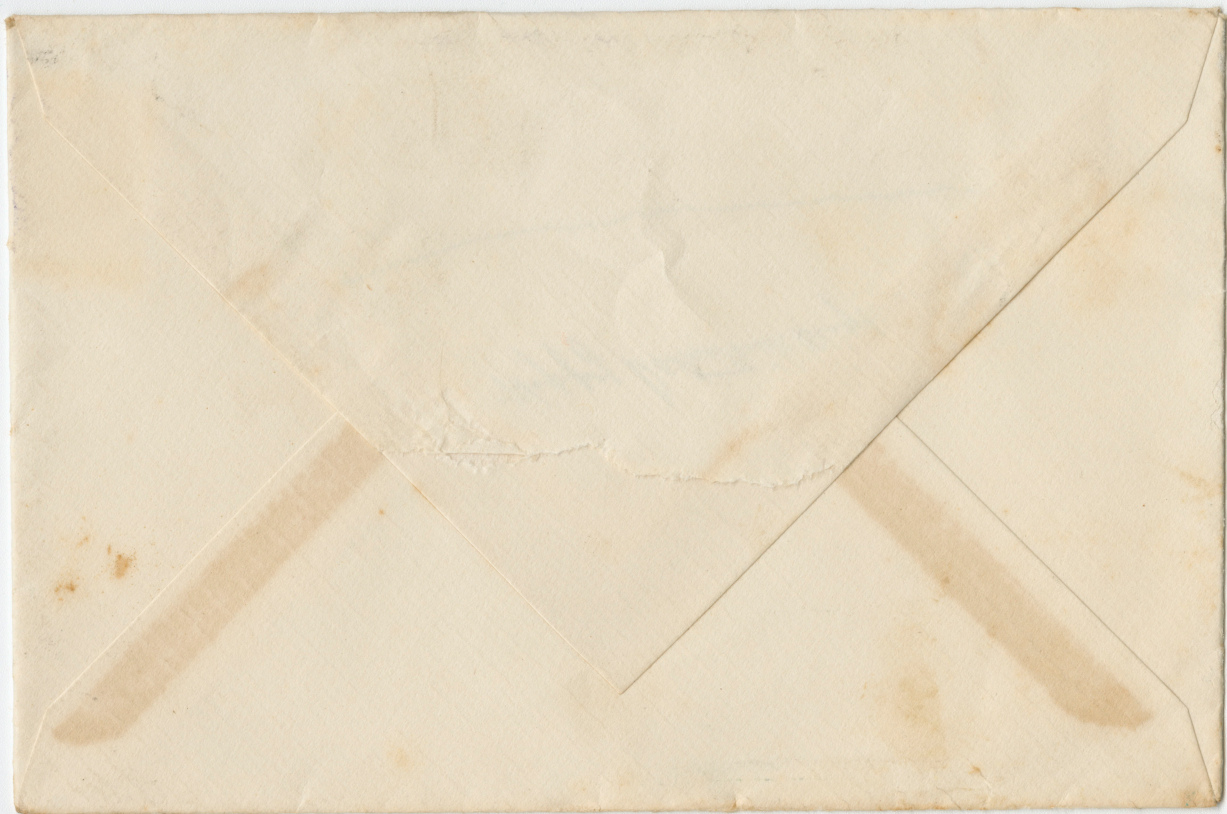

life.

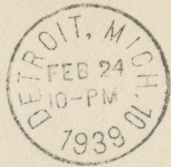
I'll certainly be glad when summer
