a private in Capt O. Wise's Company (A) of the
first Regiment of Wise Legion born in Baltimore
State of Maryland aged Twenty one years. five feet
six inches high. dark complexion black Eyes
black hair and by profession a Sailor
was enlisted by Capt. O. Wise at Richmond
on the 21st day of April eighteen Hundred and
sixty one to serve for the war, and is now
entitled to a discharge by reason of Neuralgia
and Rheumatism with which he has been
suffering for the last six weeks

The said Calvin Myers was last paid by
paymaster Cleary to include the Thirty first
day of August Eighteen Hundred and Sixty one
and has pay due him from that time to the
present day

There is due him four dollars on account
of clothing not drawn in kind
