Hope everybody is all well.


What are you'll doing this days?

They show us 3 different planes everyday. I still havent got no letters since I been here. Did you'll get many of my letters since I been gone? If you'll did why don't you'll sent me some news from home. I done wrote to every body accep them in service. But still no body answer yet maby they didn't get them yet. We have to stand guard in our bks. it is always one on for 4 hours I got mine Sun. night from 8:00 to 12:00 clock


Dearest Mom & Daddy & Jud & Leone
Hello mom and all. Heard come with few
lines. Well I must answer you'll letter
that I got today. I shure was glad
to hear from you'll. Mom in your letter
you aske what kind of clothes we wear
well we wear our a negley uniforms clothes
them that Dark Blue like they wear in
winter time. But we have 2 pairs of
work clothes just like we wear at home.
We just us them when we are all work.
I sent you'll a list of clothes that they
gave us they gave us 4 suits of white 2 suits
of Dark Blues. 2 suits of work clothes 2 work jackets
2 matras covers 2 pillow cases 1 matress 1 pillow
2 big towels 12 handtis 4 pairs of black stockings 3 pairs
of white stockings 3 white caps. 1 dark black cap. 1 nea-
cherelive 1 hairy coat. 2 of shoes 1 pair over shoes
2 good blankets and bunch of smoke klof
like brushes for clothes shoes toothbrush
ever ting we need that night we got 3 pairs
winter unders 3 pairs of shorts to
(over)

Well you ask if we just wash our under clothes no we just wash all of our clothes. But we dont iron clothes here when they are dried we sole them then they look like ironed. I gass'd all right but yesterday we took 3 shots and my arm was sore but today it all right now. Well mom I'm glad that you'll tak good care of my Dogs and guns thanks for that. Well I finely got some air mile stamps that boy that was earning mile he quit so nother boy took his place and I told him to get me som stamps he them today. I'm all right but my throte is sore and I have a cold from the cold water we have to drink they show us a short & show every day about navy how to wash clothes how to march and to salut them officers. Yes I forgot to tell you'll that I have stand guard Sun. and Thurs. always 4 hours at a time. every boodly has to searve 4 hours at a time. Mom what shall I do with them

pictures that you'll sent me. I shoule was glad to see them. I forgot to tell you'll that we have to wear lagris while we in butl traing that well be 14 to 19 weeks. We dont get all of our money. We just get \$3.00 about twice a month. Just en nofe to by our smokes. Then when we fisich our butle traing then we get all of it for our traps to home. They do this because if they would gave the money to us. We would spent it and then we would have no money to pay for our trips. I belave that is good. that they keep it. Well mom tell Leonie that I'll write next time when I have time. Because it just about time to go to bed. We have to go to bed at 9:30 and we get up at 5:15 every mouning. I still got to fisich my bed yet so this is goodly and good luck till next time which I gass be sunn.

They still wont let me go back to my bks. for some reazens. They still feeding me some more capsules and pills. I wish that quit feeding that stuff becous I'm getting tard of it. Well today is Sat. shore serty day to go to town and show and maby drink a battle of beer to. Mom tell Daddy to a battle of beer for me to. Beacous I cant dranks no beer her. Well mom that going to be right at a month seince I awy from home that maty long time for me being awy from home. I regtter be driving a trator for 50c a day for George then be her. I now that I be at home all time then. For I'm just like lost her in this country. Mom did you'll every get your garden fixed. and that sastar fanel too. mom & showe wish that they would gave me a discharge from the navy so I cougth come back to you'll help you'll farm. mom even got a letter from my best friend and you wont gass from how that bast friend I had at home that was Soney Plunkett he wrote to me the other day I was suprised when I got that letter. he wrote how he miss me too even he said that he wish that I was back at home

mom we awys doing somting for a while and then stand around maby for a hour, and that what get me, you know when I started sorting that that I like to finish it. When I was at home I always wouldn't be doing sorting. But here you just have to set around till they could grow and that uslely just for hour or so. I just cant get us to it.

Mom I gave anting that I have if I could put them old patched up breeches^{on} and my 22 cruse my sholdes and them hounds behind me go to the broghtens hunting. Mon is them chickens still leaining good yet. Well when I come home I gass I have to show you'll how to wash clought becos I getting good at that, and sweep and mop floors too. and little of house keeping too.

for I getting to be like a housewife to now. They learming us how to keep our clought clean and put togther. We have to take baths and shave every moring change unger clought to every moring. We get up at 5:15^{AM} and go to bed at 9:30^{PM} be twen time we are not aloud to go laye down on are beds till 9:30^{PM}

This ant like at home when you get ready you go lay on the bed you cant do it here. mom we cant gamble for money are like that time you gave me bunch of them pensuys to play sober we even cant play sober here. We can play

Poker for fun but not be no money becos if they catch oues that in the breg, for I still on the ball and I going trye to stay one on the ball to. Beacos them kind get by held lot easely. Well that about all for today So goodby and good luck till next time

Then one of the fellows woke me up to take some of those capsules and pills. So I dont no what happens after we went to church. It several boys got a discharge since I'm her I wish that I get one too. Because I shoule would like to be back at home with you all. Well mom to morrow is going to be a month since I left home. And it seams like a year to me. I like to be home and gave them dogs a good race

and take them hunting. Say mom did anbody
