 Hello Mom and all. Heard come with fuel
 lines. Well I must answer you'll letter
 that I got today. I shoure was glad
 to hear from you'll. Mom in your letter
 you aske what kind of clothes We wear
 well we wear our a regley uniforms clothes
 them that Dark Blue like they wear in
 winter time. But we have 2 pares of
 work clothes just like we wear at home.
 We just us them when we are all working.
 I sent you'll a list of clothes that they
 gave us & they gave us 4 suits of white 2 suits
 of Dark Blues. 2 suits of work clothes 2 work jackets
 2 matras covers 2 pillow cases. 1 matras 1 pillow
 2 big towels 12 handker 4 pair of black stockme 3 pair
 of white stocknes 3 white caps. 1 dress black cap. 1 near
 cherkine 1 heavy coat. 2 of shoes 1 pair over shoes
 2 good B blankets and bunch of smoke klobe
 like bushes for clothes shoes that bush
 ever ting we need that right we got 3 pair
 winter underwear 3 pares of shorts to
 (over)

Well you ask if you just wash our
 under clothes. no we just wash all
 of our clothes. But we dont iron clothes
 here when the are dried we roll them
 then they look like ironed. I gassed
 all right but yesterday we took shots
 and my arm was sore but today it
 all right now. Well mom Im glad that
 youll take good care of my dogs and guns
 thanks for that. Well I finally got some
 air mile stamps that boy that was caring
 mile he quit so nother boy took his place
 and I told him to get me some stamps
 he them today. Im all right but my
 throte is sore and I have a cold. from the
 cold water we have to drink I her
 show us a shirt show every day
 about navys how to wash clothes
 how to march and to salute them officers.
 Yes I forget to tell youll that I have stand
 guard Sun. and Thurs. allways 4 hours at
 a time. every boody has to serve 4 hours at
 a time. Mom what shall I do with them

We dont get all of our money. We just get \$3.00 about twice a month. Just en nefe to by our smokes. Then when we fisish our butle training then we get all of it for our traps to home. They do this becouse if they would gave the money to us. We would spent it and then we would have no money to pay for our trips. I believe that is good.

that thay keep it. Well mom thell Leona that I'll write next time when I have time. Becouse it just about time to go to bed. We have to go to bed at 9:00 and we get up at 5:15 every morning.

I still got to fixe my bed yet So this is goodly and good luck thill next time whitch I gass be sunn.

them too. Well mom shoure miss my ^{and}
and bottle of beer. We cant drank here are
fight one nother if we do we get put in
the garde house, so that mins no fighting
for me because I dont wont to be there. I
had to stand gard agan Sat. night from 8:00 to
12:00 Well mom we dont get our money
untill we finish our Bute training. We get some
moneey just \$3.00 about twice months. that we use
to by tobaccos and stuff that we need. They
hold the money so when we go home so we have it.
I believe that all right. be cause some of them went here
it when they rad to home. Well that about all for

Mom I got those 2 letters that one had \$2.00 in it well tanks for sending it I shore read it because I have to by a blue jacket mail all. 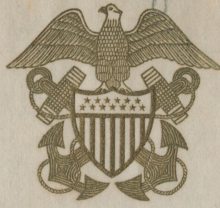

Well today is Sat. shore perty day to go to town are show and maby drink a battle of beer to. Mom tell Daddy to a battle of beer for me to. Becous I cant drank no beer her. Well mom that going to be right at a month seince I awy from home that maby long time for me being awy from home. I regter be driving a tratcov for 50c a day for George then be her. I now that I be at home all time then. For I'm just like lost her in this country. Mom did you'll every get you'll gardon fixed, and that paslar fanel too. mom & show wish that thay would gave me a discharge from the navy so I cougth come bech to you'll help you'll farm. mom & even got a letter from my best frand and you wont gass from how That bast frand I had at home that was Soney Plunkett he wrote to me the other day I was supried when I got that letter. he wrote how he miss me too even he read that he wish that I was back at home

mom we awys doing somting for a while and then
stand around maby for a hour, and that what get me,
you know when I started sorting that that I like
to finish it. When I was at home I always
would be doing somting. But her you just have
to set around thill they could you and that usley
just for hour are so. I just cant get us to it.

mom I gave anting that I have if I could put
them old patched up breeches^{on} and my 22 crows my
sholder and them hounds behind me go to the
brogthens hunting. Mom is them chickness still
leaing good yet. Well when I come home I
gass I have to show youll how to wash clought
becous I getting good at that, and sweep and mop
floors too, and little of house keeping too.

for I getting to be like a housewife to now. They
leaug us how to cheep our clought clean and put
toghter. We have to take baths and shave every
moring change unger clought to every moring. We get
up at 5:15^{AM} and go to bed at 9:30^{PM} be twen thme we are
not aloud to go laye down on are beds thill 9:30^{PM}

This ant like at home when you get rady you
go lay on the bed you cant do it her. mom we

cant gamble for money are like that time you
gave me bunch of them pennys to play poker
we even cant play poker here. We can play

Poker for fun but not be no money becous if
they catch us that in the beg, for I still
on the ball and I going trye to stay one
on thl ball to. Becous them kind get by hold lot
easy. Well that about all for today So goodby and
good luck till next time

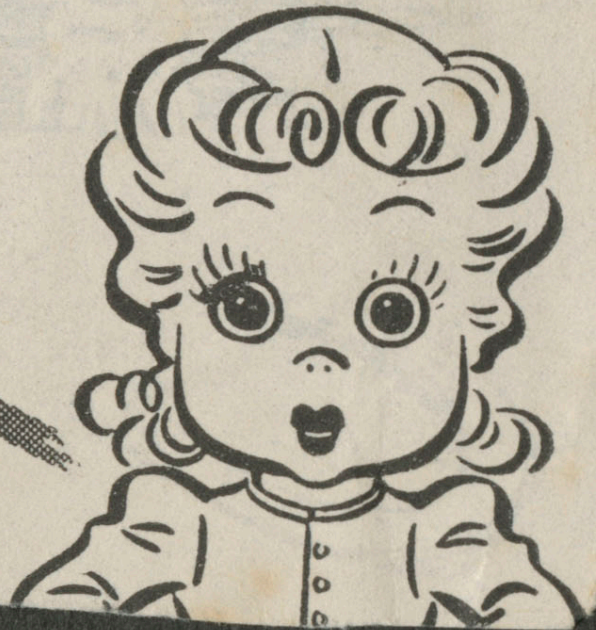
