Richmond Va at 10 A.M. 25<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Dear Wife

I recived your kind letter  
today I was very glad to here from  
you I was very glad to here that  
your health is good I wish you  
could get some one to do your  
planting for you you must get some  
one to do your hoing for you doent  
try to do it yourself for it is to much  
for you to do I am in hopes to be  
home in time to do some of it  
myself I think I shall be at home  
soon perhaps sooner then you think  
the story I spoke about in my  
letter is nothing but a camp story  
there is a prospect of having a hard  
battle at Richmond if the rebels  
make a stand which I think they

will if they do not I don't think  
they ever will I do not think we  
shal see much of the fight if there  
is one for we are held in reserve  
our position is behind all the rest  
At Stephen E. Tommboy we get  
nearly better then we used to be  
we get our Whiskey twice a day  
now by order of general McClellan  
let him to merit to us

We expect to be paid in a day or  
two let father I shall send it  
home as soon as I get it I sent  
all the money home I could  
before I had to buy me a pair  
of Boots they cost \$5.00 and  
they was rather poor at that  
I would like to see ant Mary  
Hays very much give my  
love to her if she is not gone  
home before you get this
