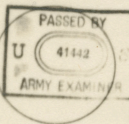

Dear Ann,

Now is everything back in good ole Miss. coming along now. Well, Ann, just at present I might say that your eldest brother is somewhat tired. This morning we made a nice little ten mile hike, and I got pretty tired as my feet aren't in the best of condition. I have a little case of athlete's feet, and the walking didn't help it very much from the way my feet are feeling right now. But the Medics have some pretty good medicine so my feet should be better soon. And tomorrow is a day off, and that should get me pretty well rested. Have you had your tonsils removed yet? Maybe by now they don't bother you anymore.

Guess that you and Mother have already had letters from Baby for Poppa and Daddy wrote that they did. But I haven't heard a thing from him since he left here. So in your next letter to him maybe you had better give his address for he probably doesn't know it. Guess that Mother and Daddy were pretty relieved when they got their first letter from him at his new location.

And speaking of new locations this new place of ours isn't exactly the best spot in the world, but in some ways it isn't too bad. I can play pool at night, we have a theatre, a beer garden, nice PX, the sun shines when it isn't raining, the mosquitoes don't buzz when they bite you so taking everything into consideration I guess we have no right to complain. Especially we have no right to complain when talking to some of these boys that have been down knocking off the Japs. But on clear days here it is awfully hot, but I guess that back at home now it is also getting to be pretty hot weather.

Have you been getting letters regularly from your "true one". And if you know where he is, let me know. Do you and Elizabeth get around much anymore, or are you so tired on weekends that you just stay around the house mostly. I'll bet that Poppa is pretty hard to get away from on Sundays. Ann, I want to thank you again for the pictures, and all of them were nice. Tell Annie Mae to have some pictures of Mary K. and Cynthia made and send me one or two for I sure would like to see a picture of them. Is Mansel still working at the same place you are? I should write to all of my aunts and uncles once in awhile, but I just don't know much to write about.

Walker still writes pretty often, and I enjoy all his letters though he writes very little of what he is doing or where he is. He and I used to have some good times together even if it was nothing other than playing dominoes and checkers. And he is one person that I always write back to when he writes me, and I try to keep one up on him.

Well, Ann, as you see this is a pretty dull letter so I guess I will close for this time. Maybe next time there will be a few interesting things to write you.

Tell Momma and Poppa hello and that I enjoy all their letters even though I don't write so very much. Be good and write soon.
