

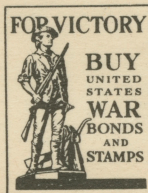
Dear Sir:

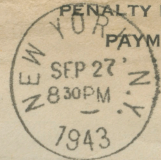
