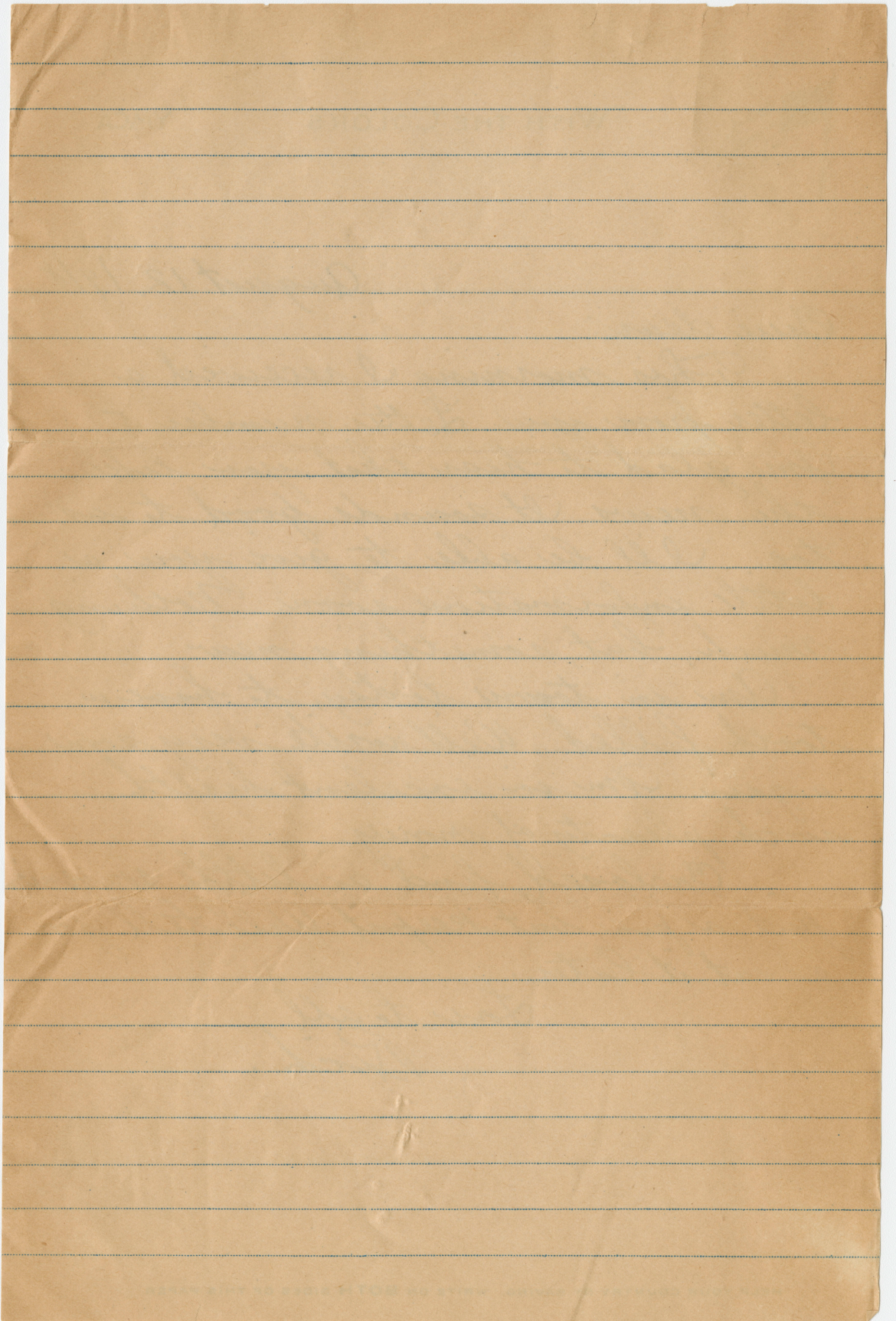
Essie dear:
