 63^d Reg^t P. V.

Sir - Herewith I send you a very rude attempt at a plan of the scene of operations, of April 11th 1862 of a portion of the right wing of the 63^d P. V. then under your command. I was ordered by you in the night of April 10/62 to take my Co ("C.") and act in conjunction with Co "A." (Lt Smith Comd^g) in taking possession of a series of rifle pits on the North and West fronts of a "Peach Orchard" on the Yorktown road about 2 1/2 miles or thereabouts from these Head Quarters, at the same time relieving a detachment of the 5th Mich. Vol. who had been occupying them for the preceding 24 hours. (These pits are along inside the fence between the points "R.", "P.", "S.") - This I done, and reported myself, with my reserve (15 men + officers) to you at the wood (Reserve) at daylight according to your orders - You there gave me charge of Co "E." (the Captain being sick) and directed me to place some sentinels along the fence to the West of the road - I accordingly done so, stationing them as per diagram "A.", "A.", "A.", "A." (four in all) - There had been no posts here before you ordered them, that I could discover traces of, or hear of - Cap^t Danks "Co E." had made posts marked "A.B.", "A.B.", on the night of the 10th and these remained in place until relieved by 25th Md^a Mass^a Reg^t on the night of the 11th - The dotted lines (-----) represent the course taken by a line of skirmishers of the 2^d Mich^a on the night of the 11th under the guidance of my O.S. - The heavy line (—) shows where 150 men were deployed during the fight and where they remained, until ordered in after the

arrival of the 2^d Mich.

"H." where I had the reserve through the night of the 10th.

(oooooooo) line of skirmishers of 22^d Mass thrown out and deployed across after dark on the night of the 11th.
