that our com<sup>rs</sup> have arriv'd.

If no report is soon rec<sup>d</sup>, it will merit considera-  
-tion whether an answer should be delay'd, longer,  
d from the hands of the Spanish minister. I am inclin'd

that however desirable to have the whole  
of your regard before us, a safe answer might be given
